## **AL NAHRAIN & GRAND ARABIA**WITH 1ST LOT OF TELECOMMUNICATION TOWERS

During October 2017, Al Nahrain and Grand Arabia in Iraq carried out the transportation of the first lot of telecommunication towers for a project contracted by Al-Atheer Company for Communications and Zain Group.

Once assembled, the telecommunications towers are equipped with wheeled cabinets meaning they can be towed - check out the photos above. This first lot involved 5 towers, each at 9,200kgs / 60cbm, which were picked up at Umm Qasr Port and transported to the consignee's warehouses in several Iraqi Governorates; Basra, Karbala, Baghdad and Kirkuk.

Director of Operations & Logistics Services at Al Nahrain, Ragheb S. Banat explains: "This project is being completed as a collective effort with Grand Arabia Company. After completing the handling process and clearance formalities at Umm Qasr Port, the delivery of this shipment was done in two stages.

From Umm Qasr Port to our warehouse in Safwan using flat-bed trailers.

From our warehouse in Safwan to several final destinations across Iraq using truck-tractors with expert drivers to tow the cabinets and towers, accompanied by patrol escorts and supported with continuous follow ups to ensure safe deliveries.

At our warehouse in Safwan, we de-stuffed the cargo from the containers using the necessary equipment and tools and covered them for safety purposes. As per our client's request, we also arranged a team of qualified engineers to assemble and install the towers with their wheeled cabinets to be ready for transportation as complete units. Suitable truck-tractors then towed the units to their final destinations.

This multi-task project handled as a collaboration shows the added value services of both Al Nahrain and Grand Arabia."

## **AL NAHRAIN** EXECUTES PROJECT IN 3 LOTS FOR MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES IN IRAQ

At the end of 2017,
Al Nahrain in Iraq handled
a project for the Ministry
of Water Resources
(MOWR). The cargo was
transported from Umm
Qasr Port to the MOWR
warehouse in Baghdad in
three separate lots. For
each lot, Al Nahrain's scope
of work included port
handling, customs clearance
and inland transportation.
Please check out the photos
above and below.

The first lot, handled in October, consisted of 12 open-top containers loaded with mobile dosing stations plus spare parts, concrete batching plant sections and crew container sections. Each container had a gross weight of 9tns. Director of Operations and Logistics Services at Al Nahrain, Ragheb S. Banat explains: "After receiving the cargo

at Umm Qasr Port, we prepared the necessary for a smooth handling. Then, the cargo was stored at a safe and guarded area until the exemption documentation was ready from the MOWR. Once the customs formalities were completed, the containers were loaded and the trucks departed on the same day headed to Baghdad. Due to the sensitivity of the shipment, on arrival at the MOWR warehouse, we arranged a special mobile crane to safely handle the cargo from the containers with care. All empty containers were then returned back to the carrier's yard at Umm Qasr Port."

The second lot, handled in November, consisted of 6 units of silo trailers at a gross weight of 13tns each. Ragheb comments: "The shipment arrived at Umm Qasr Port by RORO vessel and after discharging, the trailers were handled and towed to the storage yard. After customs and documentation formalities, an inspection of the vehicles and the completion of processes from all related departments, we arranged suitable trucks and tractors as the trailers needed to be towed. All trucks reached the final destination in Baghdad and the delivery was completed smoothly and in good order."

The third lot, handled in December, consisted of 13 units of concrete mixers at 12.8tns each and 3 units of mobile workshops at 7.2tns each. Ragheb S. Banat: "This shipment also arrived at Umm Qasr Port by RORO vessel and being self-propelled, the

vehicles were quickly discharged and driven to the storage yard. After customs, documentation and inspection formalities, we arranged the required low-bed trailers which were loaded under the supervision of our expert team who applied the proper lashing and required chains with the whole process controlled with full safety and security as usual. All vehicles departed Umm Qasr Port as one convoy, escorted by our equipped patrols, front and rear, and arrived safe and sound at the final destination in Baghdad."

Congratulations to Al Nahrain for the successful completion of the entire project with complete care to the full satisfaction of their client.

## MILESTONE & KRONOZ DEVELOP AUTOMATED TANK WASHING CENTER

Milestone Logistics (members in Spain), through Kronoz Internacional (members in Mexico and the USA), have developed an automated tank washing center in the port of Veracruz with the maximum guarantees, traceability and food grade controls for the export of juice by sea.

"This development has saved economic and time costs when making these transfers that were previously made by land and has put us among the market leaders in the export of citrus juices to the USA with 2,500 tanks and a total of 60 million litres of this beverage annually in the country.

The development of the tank washing center has been carried out together with Odyssey and DA Hinohosa and guarantees the highest standards of quality and traceability of the product. It has the required standards for the commercialisation of foods in the USA according to the Federal Law of Food, Drugs and Cosmetics (FDCA) establishing the application of BPMs.

In the center, four types of washing are carried out depending on the liquid and the situation of the isotank. These four types are for loads of the same product, for different products between loads, for oily products and for food grade for previous loads of allergenic products.

The traceability and quality of these processes are also supported by two demanding certifications, meeting specifications required by the JPA (Juice Products Association) for food grade washing and KOSHER accreditation. The latter guarantees the quality of the food and that some food groups have not come together with others under Jewish standards.

The juices, which are collected by land from different parts of Mexico and distributed through the port of Veracruz, by

sea, in isotanks to the USA, where their main destination is the state of Florida."

The CEO of Kronoz Internacional, Alex Lasheras, further explains: "At the moment, the main destination of citrus liquids is the region of Florida since, due to the impact of meteorological phenomena and phytosanitary situations, it is proving impossible for them to count on the raw material of these juices to harvest. The citrus juices exported are basically fresh juice and orange concentrate, Persian lemon and taronja, as well as orange juice concentrate oil. So far, Mexico, Brazil and Florida have been the main producing and leading countries in the transport of juices and citrus juices."
