ATHENA & H2B COLLABORATE ON SHIP ENGINE TRANSPORT TO DUBAI

Athena Global Logistics and PT. Harmoni Harapan Bersama (also known as H2B) are pleased to share a recent collaborative effort they completed, involving the transport of a ship engine and machinery from Indonesia to Dubai. The cargo originated in Ambon, Indonesia with import formalities handled at Surabaya - the Port of Loading for the shipment.

Once loaded aboard the vessel, the ship engine was transported across the ocean successfully to the port of **Jebel Ali** in **Dubai**.

Three 40' flat racks were used carrying the main block of the engine (41 MT), the alternator (30 MT) and the base frame (28 MT).

The scope of work also covered customs clearance, loading & unloading, cleaning & reworking, lashing & choking, packing & inspection as well as freight bookings and the conducting of a 3rd party survey.


Our gathering significantly saved our Members valuable time away from their offices and reduced substantial travel expenses by facilitating **P2P meetings in a single location**.

Athena Global Logistics have recently handled a huge breakbulk project for a power plant with cargo moved from India to the UAE.

The cargo of power **plant machinery and parts** in a dismantled condition originated in Gujarat before transport to the POL of Mumbai for shipping to Jebel Ali, UAE. The gross weight of the shipment totalled **440mtn** with 126 pieces.

- 2 x Main Generators Each at 136mtn
- 116 x Spare Parts (including compressors, panels, filters, pipes, etc.) 73mtn
- 7 x 40'HC Containers with Spares & Accessories 80mtn
- 1 x 40'OT Container with Spares & Accessories 15mtn

Athena were responsible for an extensive scope of work including registration, pre-inspection, planning, carting, transportation, fumigation, examination, measurements, painting, labelling, port handling, under-hook movement, valuation, customs, packing, surveys, freight handling and shipping.


