PRAGUE

We will travel in groups of 30 guided by professional licensed English speaking guides.

The walking tour will start at our hotel and will include the Municipal House, Powder Tower, Na Příkopě Stroet, Theatre of the Estates

At the bottom of Wenceslas Square (Můstek) we will learn about the historic period between 1968-1989, then we'll go to the Old Town Square to see the famous Astronomical Clock, Týn Church, Monument of John Hus, Kinsky Palace and St. Nicholas Church.

Then we will walk through Paris Avenue where we will learn about the Metronome on the other side of the Vltava River and then explore the Jewish Quarter where we will see the oldest synagogue in Central Europe.

We will then return to the Old Town past St. Nicholas Church and continue to Mariánské Square to see the City Library and the New Town Hall and then we'll go through the complex of Klementinum passing the Chapel of Mirrors and the National Library on the way to the Charles Bridge with beautiful views of the Prague Castle Complex, Straka Academy and the National Theatre.

We'll cross over to the Lesser Town and walk to see the John Lennon wall, French Embassy and the Church of Our Lady under the Chain.

Then we will walk through the Kampa Island along the Kampa Museum to Vítězná Street where buses will be waiting to take us on a round trip to see the Strahov area, passing the Royal Garden down to the river along the Bílek's Vila and back to the hotel.

The tour is suitable for most people and there are no major hills.
